EYFS

A “Good Level of Development” is defined by pupils reaching at least the Early Learning Goal (“Expected”) in every strand of the Prime Areas of Development (Communication and Language, Physical Development and Personal and Social Development) and in both strands of each of Literacy and Mathematics. A “Good Level of Development” is the national expectation for pupil attainment at the end of the Foundation Stage year.

- Key stage 2 attainment of the expected standard in mathematics (97%) was significantly above national and in the highest 20% of all schools in 2019.
- The three-year average mathematics attainment score (106.6) was in the highest 20%.
- Writing outcomes remain strong.
- Reading shows a downward trend and robust action plans are in place to halt this decline.
